

Sub-Committee on Conservation Policy.

Meeting on 12 June 1984. Joy Shires, Cally Pears, Jan Wallis, Margaret Brown,
Jan Mullins, Bob Fenton, Mike Doyle, Ken Knight.

1. Denis Buckland by invitation described work on a plan/survey for his parish, in which 110 households of 118 participated. Plan finalised after 18 months. Numerous questions discussed and analysed. But it didn't prevent Winchester College selling land on which a large number (conspicuously) of houses were built. Dorset Community Council involved!
2. As regards S.P., it was agreed that a similar survey etc would be too late. A conservation appraisal would, however, be useful. Action to be taken:
 - (a) Bob Fenton will check on the list of "listed" buildings;
 - (b) Jan Mullins & Margaret Brown will liaise with Mr Saville on an examination of trees in the village (Bob F. will contact Saville).
 - (c) Joy Shires will enlarge the map of the village
 - (d) Ken Knight will examine various village plans to see what common threads exist
 - (e) Everyone will come to a meeting on 23/7/84 with an idea of sites to be retained undeveloped.

Meeting on 23 ^{JULY} ~~JUNE~~ 84 All present except J. Wallis & M. Brown.
Bob Fenton appointed Chairman. He produced a list of "listed buildings" - pointing that Bellamy Cottage, Cob Cottage and Wyndings not included (Bob to speak to Bill Mercer and Joy S. to Buildings).

Bob F said Kelly (Planning Dept) would welcome a plan for the village & would be glad to comment on

own draft. Agreed -

- (i) Conservation area ought to be extended to cover virtually whole of village East of Knaibers Lane - to be referred to in draft;
- (ii) Electricity lines ought to go underground - to be put again to S.P.S. Committee
- (iii) Use of footpaths (especially that behind Mission Hall Lane) should be looked at - to be referred to S.P.S.

The 1976 conservation policy was considered paragraph by paragraph and various amendments, deletions etc suggested. Jay Slives will prepare a revised version.
